

Articles of Incorporation

A Virginia Non-Stock Not-Profit Corporation

The undersigned, a citizens of the United States, desiring to form Non Stock and Non Profit Corporation pursuant to the Non-Profit Corporation laws of Virginia, Chapter 10 of Title 13.1 of the Code of Virginia do hereby certify:

Article 1: Name of the organization:

Capital Business Connections, Inc.

Article 11: The initial principal address of the Corporation shall be at:

Article 111: Said Corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, educational, cultural and promotion of business and partnership, and as a national and business forum for Arabs, Arab-Americans and Americans of diverse ethnicity and faith to: A) Build bridges between Arab Americans and American business persons, individuals and corporate and professionals business communities through networking events, cultural programs, and professional development opportunities. B) Establish robust mentorship programs pairing experienced professionals and emerging leaders, C) Create internship and training opportunities for students and young professionals in member’s organizations. D) Promote cultural understanding and economic collaboration during challenging times. E) Advocate for inclusive business practices and diverse professional opportunities, F) Hold periodic “Business Round Table” for members over breakfast, lunch or dinner with local and national selected prominent speakers. G) Host annual Capital Business Connections’ Forum and Gala for members and guests, H) Work with other communities, business leadership in major cities such as NYC, Chicago, Detroit, Dallas, Houston, Los Angeles, San Francisco, Tampa, and other cities to set up similar affiliated chapters around the country for example Chicago Business Connections”. I) Organize cultural exchange events. J) Establish educational workshops on cross-cultural business practices. K) Establish and publish periodic publications of its activities and membership directory. L) Organize periodic professional delegations from the Arab World to visit major corporations, think tanks, universities, consulting firms, and health care institutions here in the US and organize visiting delegations from the US to Arab countries promoting partnership with US corporations and businesses and hosting business and professional delegations from the Arab World during their visits to the US and serve as membership business club and associations.

Article 1V: In furtherance of its objectives, mission and mandate the Corporation shall have the rights to enter into partnerships and or associations with national and international organizations business and professional organizations, academic institutions, public policy institutions, foundations, national or international institutions with competency and expertise in fulfillment of the Corporation mission and vision.

Article V: The Corporation is a membership corporation with membership paying fees, and is open to business leaders, executives and employees of health care organization to include executive, physicians, nurses and employees. Open to university administrators, executives, professors, staff and students. Open to banking and financial institutions executives and employees. Open to World Bank and International Monetary Fund executives, senior staff and employees. Open to member staff of diplomatic organizations in their capacity as individuals. Open to executive staff and employees of the federal and state government in their private capacity. Open to executives and staff of hospitality, labor, aviation, think tanks, consulting, legal associations and law firms, accounting firms, graduate college students, and transportation organizations.

The paid members shall have equal votes and powers to nominate and elect corporate Board of Directors and Officers, and shall also have the powers to nominate members of the advisory board. Members of the Board of Directors and officers shall serve two consecutive terms of 2 years each. Officers and members of the Board of Directors will serve gratuitously with no salaries but will be compensated for services and all out of pocket expenses related to activities in furtherance of the objective and mission of the Corporation. Official staff full time or part time will be a salary employee. All these rights, procedures and obligations shall be stated in the corporate By-Laws.

Article V1: The initial corporate Board of Directors and officer is Sami Jamil Jadallah, is a citizen and resident of the Commonwealth of Virginia with resident at 12707 Hunt Manor Court, Fairfax, VA 22033 which address shall be the initial registered address of the Corporation.

Article V11: The Corporation shall have donors, contributors, sponsors and members; individuals and corporate and sponsors who are not officials of US government and or officials of foreign governments and shall have the rights to raise public funds directly and earn income through services, professional events, and consultations to international or national business and professional corporation consistent with the Corporation mission and purpose and shall have the rights to list names of individuals and corporate donors in its publications. International business and diplomatic commercial delegations shall have the rights to sponsor events consistent with the objective and mission of the corporation.

Article V111: The name of the Corporation's initial registered agent is:

Sami Jamil Jadallah, is a founding members of the Board of Directors and initial officer and is a US citizen, and citizen and resident of the Commonwealth of Virginia, with address at 12707 Hunt Manor Court, Fairfax, County of Fairfax VA 22033, and shall maintain this address as his business address.

Article 1X: The income from members and corporate fees and donations to the Corporation shall go toward operating expenses and pay for services in furtherance of the mission and objectives of the corporations. Funds which shall not be used in any way and involvement in partisan politics local or national and international and lobbying for and on behalf of domestic or international groups, and otherwise shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried out on (a) by a corporation exempted from federal income tax under section 501 (C) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future State or federal codes, or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170 (C) (2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any federal tax code.

Article X: Upon the dissolution of the Corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501 (C) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for public purposes. Any such assets, not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a Court of Competent Jurisdiction, of a state and county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operate executively for such purposes.
